What is Naloxone or Narcan?

Naloxone or Narcan blocks or reverses the effects of opioid medication. An opioid is sometimes called a narcotic.

Purpose:

Naloxone or Narcan is used to treat a narcotic overdose in an emergency. This medicine should not be used in place of emergency medical care for an overdose.

Data Collection:

Data regarding the incidence and administration of Naloxone or Narcan is vital for the purposes of system improvement and analysis. Everyone that is trained must submit a monthly 1-page log by the 5th of each month to Darlene D. Owens (dowens@dwihn.org) and Nakia Payton (npayton@dwihn.org).
