Services may include...

- Support Coordination, in your home, school or community
- Therapy to address ongoing behavioral/emotional concerns of children and teens
- Psychiatry, or Medication Management
- Advocacy for your child
- Community Living Supports
- Respite
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech Therapy

Who is Eligible?

- Children on Medicaid or Medicaid eligible, who meet the additional criteria:
- Residents of Wayne County
- Child must have a documented developmental disability and need medical or behavioral supports and services at home.

What to Expect from My Support Coordinator?

- Visits in your home, school or community at least once per month.
- Supports to understand the needs of your child
- Guidance/advocacy in times of crisis
- Help connecting the family to the community for support and resources
