MichiCANS Demonstration

- PCE will be working with providers to select where they want the MichiCANS Screening and MichiCANS Comprehensive to be in their electronic health record (EHR).
- PCE will also allow providers to select where they want the service support decision (i.e. the pre plan provides recommended services but then the IPOS meeting determines the actual services so there will be a place in the EHR to document why certain services were selected and why certain services were not selected from the pre-plan meeting).

- ▶ Please use a cover page or include a note to explain the reason for the communication and the contact person
- ▶ Give the Access Call Center a follow up call if you request has not been processed within 24 hour
- ▶ Incomplete documents will be returned to you and may delay the processing of your request
 - ▶ CRSP enrollment Forms
 - ▶ SED, DD or SMI Checklists
 - ▶ CCBHC enrollment forms
 - ▶ Consents / Release of information

What's Next?

- Effective 10/1/24 Children Providers to use MichiCANS Screener. Providers to continue to submit the Consumer Enrollment Packet in addition to the MichiCANS Screener.
- Plan to review the Consumer Enrollment Packet and Screening Checklists to reduce any screening redundancies with the new MichiCANS screener
- Pending Memo – Providers begin submitting the Consumer Enrollment Packet via a smartsheet
- DWIHN Access Department to also begin completing screenings for children ages 0 to 6 and schedule intakes with Infant Mental Health Providers
- Host another MichiCANS Q&A Session prior to 10/1/24 for Providers, Stakeholders, and Members Served

DWIHN's Crisis Care Center-opened Monday, June 10, 2024.

- It was designed to provide comprehensive support under one roof, the Crisis Care Center offers specialized care for children, adolescents and adults in crisis, including crisis walk-ins, crisis stabilization, and the peer-led program and Building Empowered Supportive Transition (B.E.S.T.).
- It is 24/7, 365 days a year.

- For referrals, contact 313-989-9444. However, walk ins can visit the Center for assistance.

DWIHN's Crisis Care Center (continued)

➤ **There are three (3) units:**

- Adult Crisis Stabilization-twelve (12) beds for eighteen (18) and older to address mental health and/or substance use crisis with length of stay being seventy-two (72) hours. It is a voluntary and involuntary unit.
- Child and Family Crisis-fourteen (14) beds for five (5) through seventeen (17) to address mental health with length of stay being seventy-two (72) hours. It is a voluntary unit and requires parent/legal guardian to accompany the child during their stay.
- BEST-six (6) beds for eighteen (18) years and older for mental health and substance use crisis with length of stay being seventy-two (72) hours. However, this is a transitional unit which is peer lead.
