FY 2018/2019 through FY 2020/2021

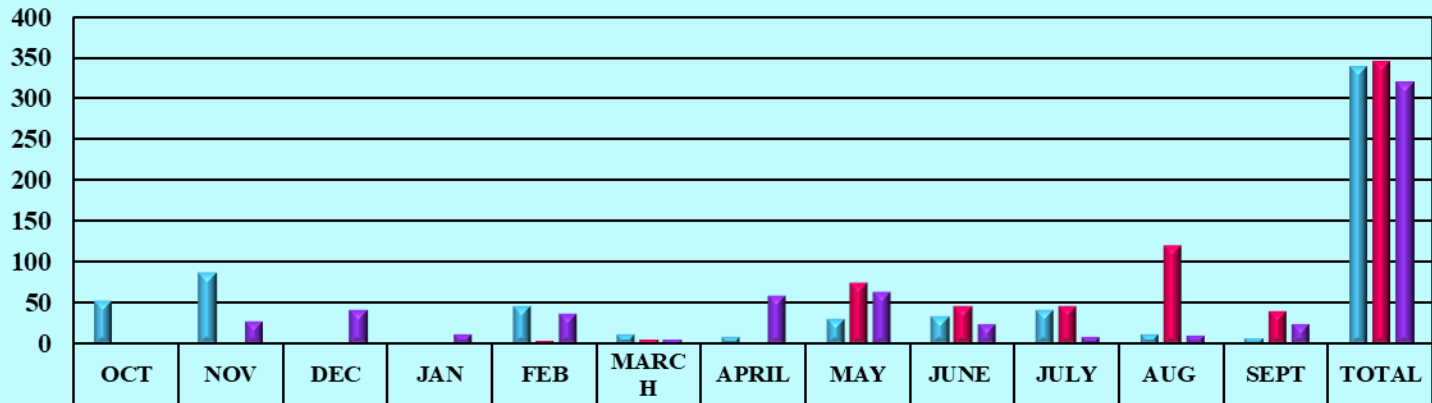


The data in this report reflects a comparison for three years FY 2018/2019 through FY 2020/2021 of Critical/Sentinel Events in DWIHN’s system of care. During FY 2020/2021 the Quality Performance Improvement staff worked with the IT Department upgrading category/subcategories of reporting in MHWIN. These improvements have resulted in clearer identification of trends and patterns within DWIHN system of care. In FY 2021/2022, the Quality Performance Improvement team is redesigning the Critical/Sentinel Event training with an expanded Glossary of Terms to reduce redundancies and mis-categorization of events.

Training directly related to Critical/Sentinel Events for the entire DWIHN system remains a focus. By aligning definitions more appropriately for each category/sub-category, a more comprehensive picture of the DWIHN systems’ patterns and trends provides targeted guidance for the development of training and program enhancements in specific areas of the needs of those we serve.



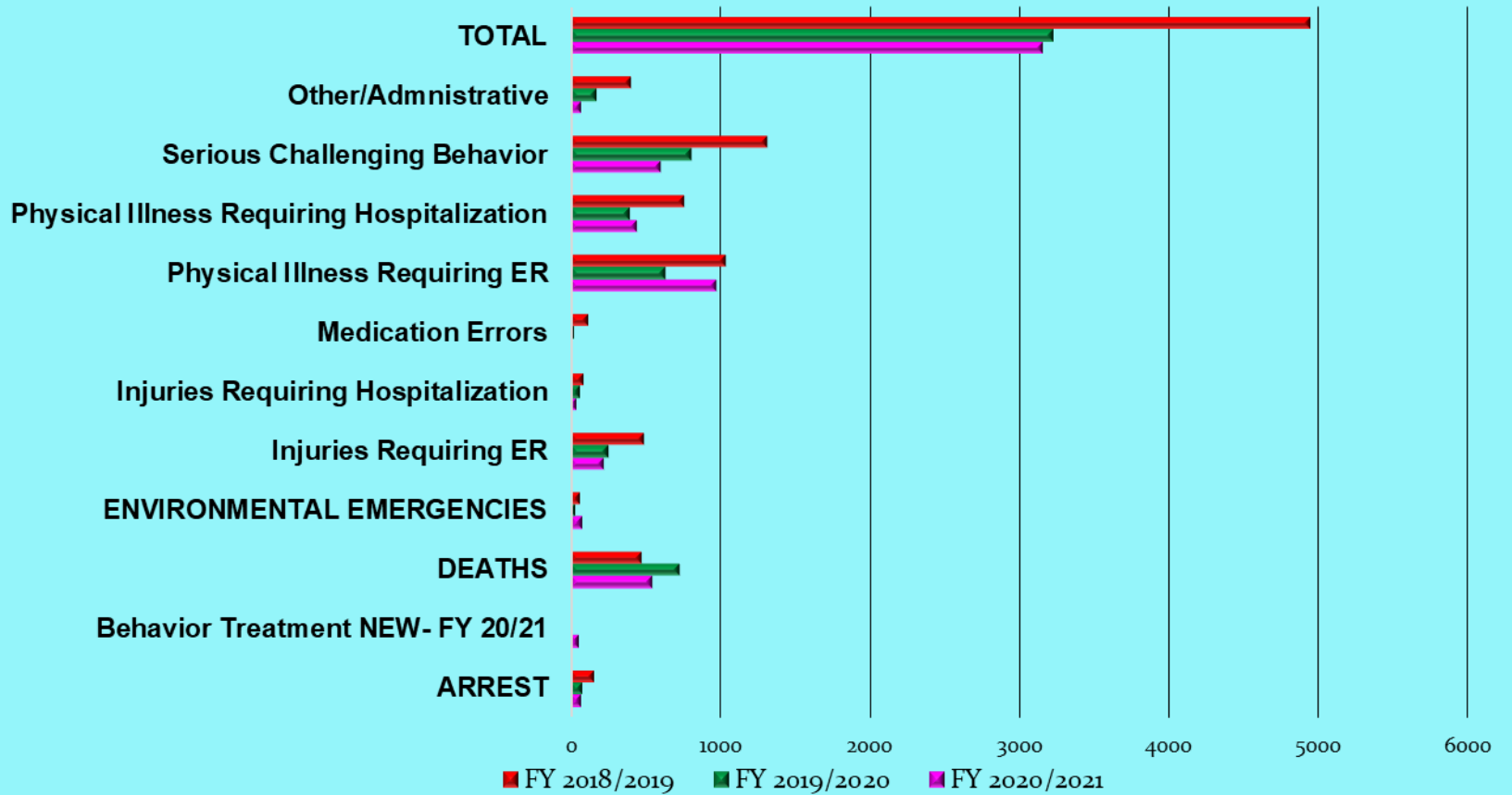
STAFF TRAINING

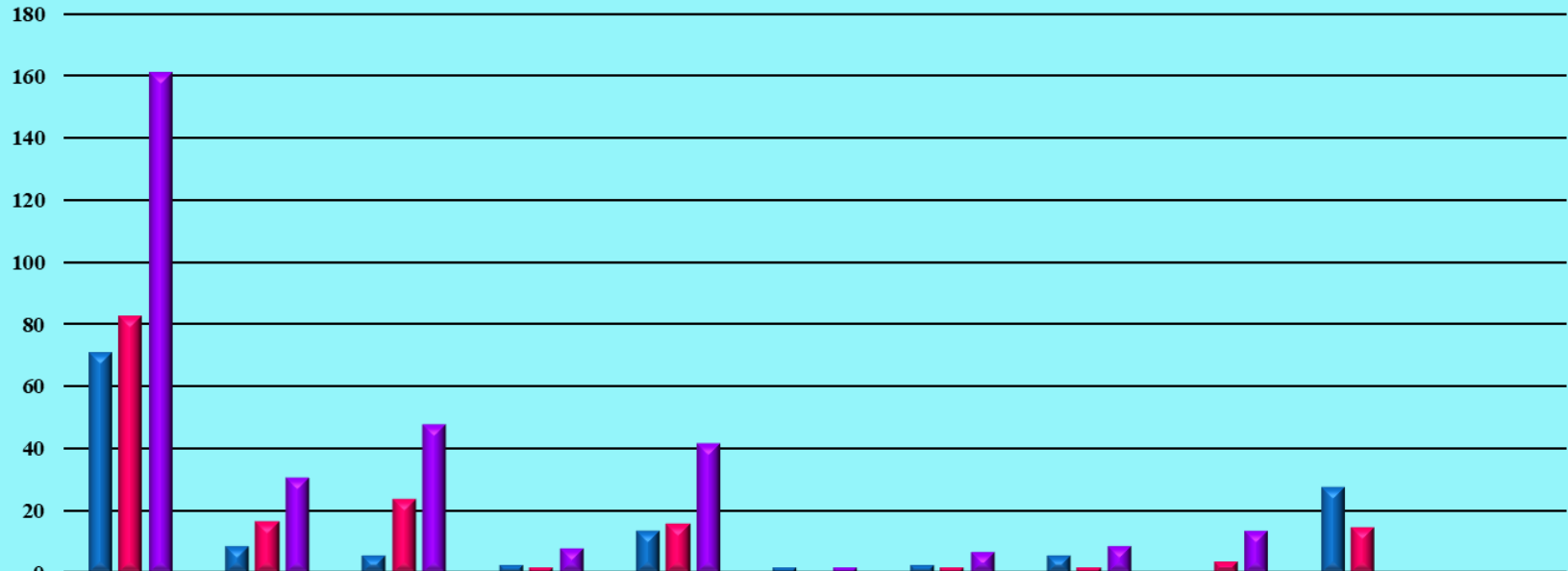
THREE YEAR ANNUAL COMPARISON DATA FY 2018/2019 THROUGH FY 2020/2021

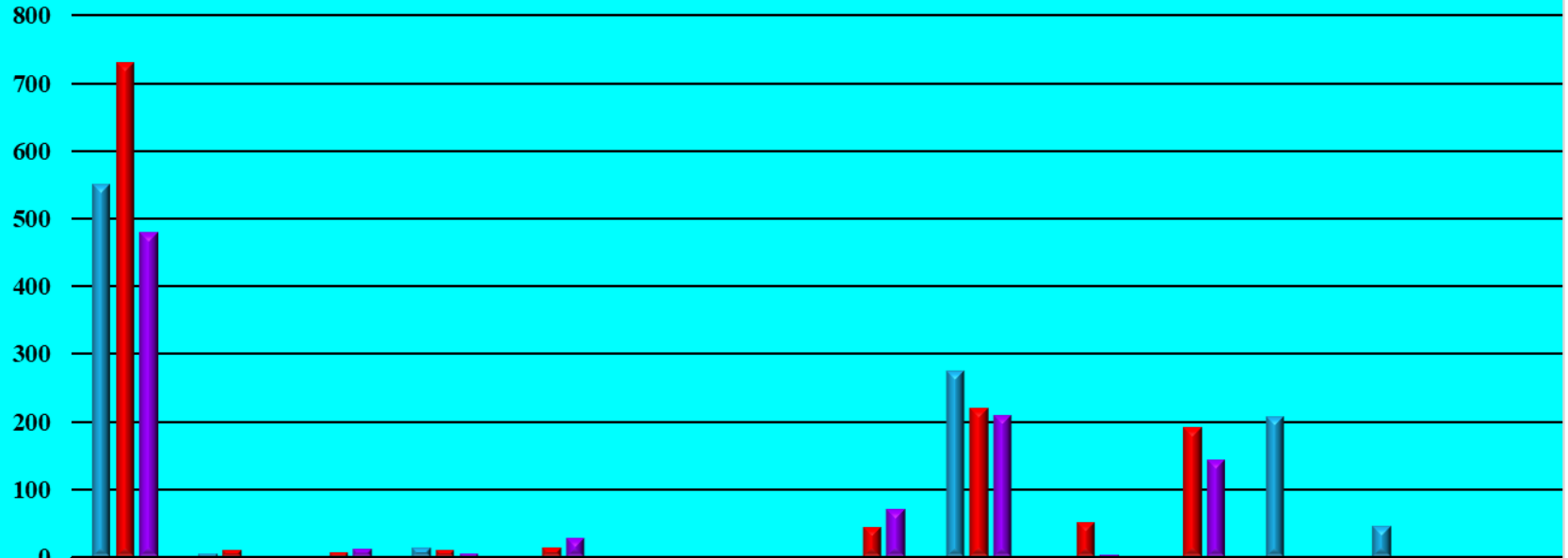

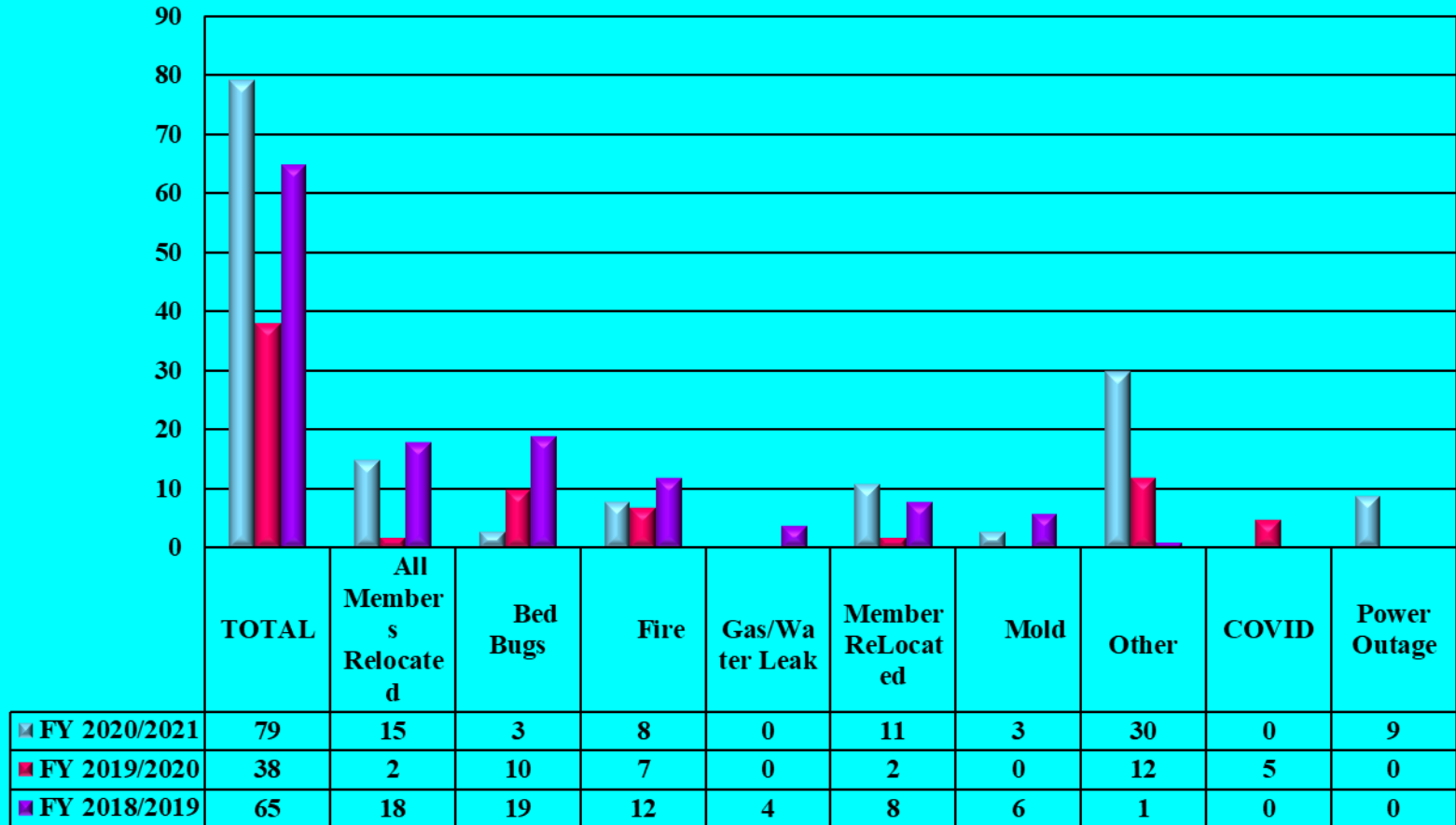

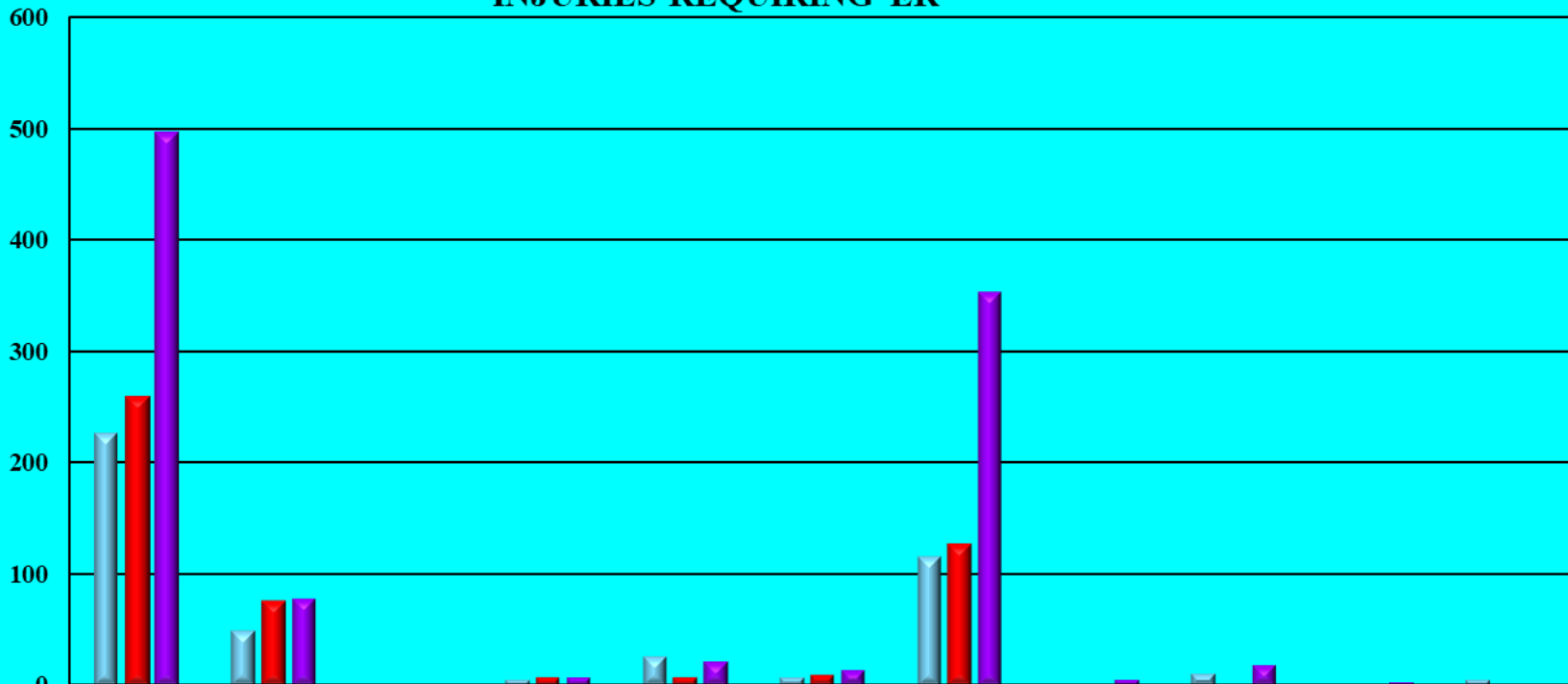

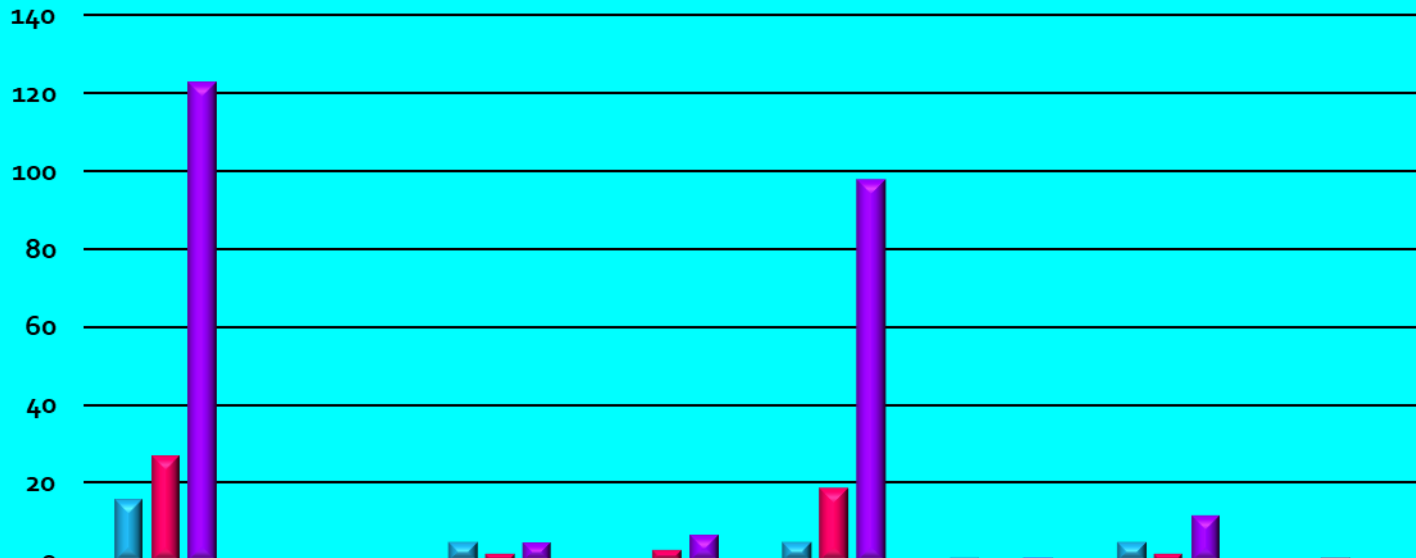


Injuries Requiring Hospitalization

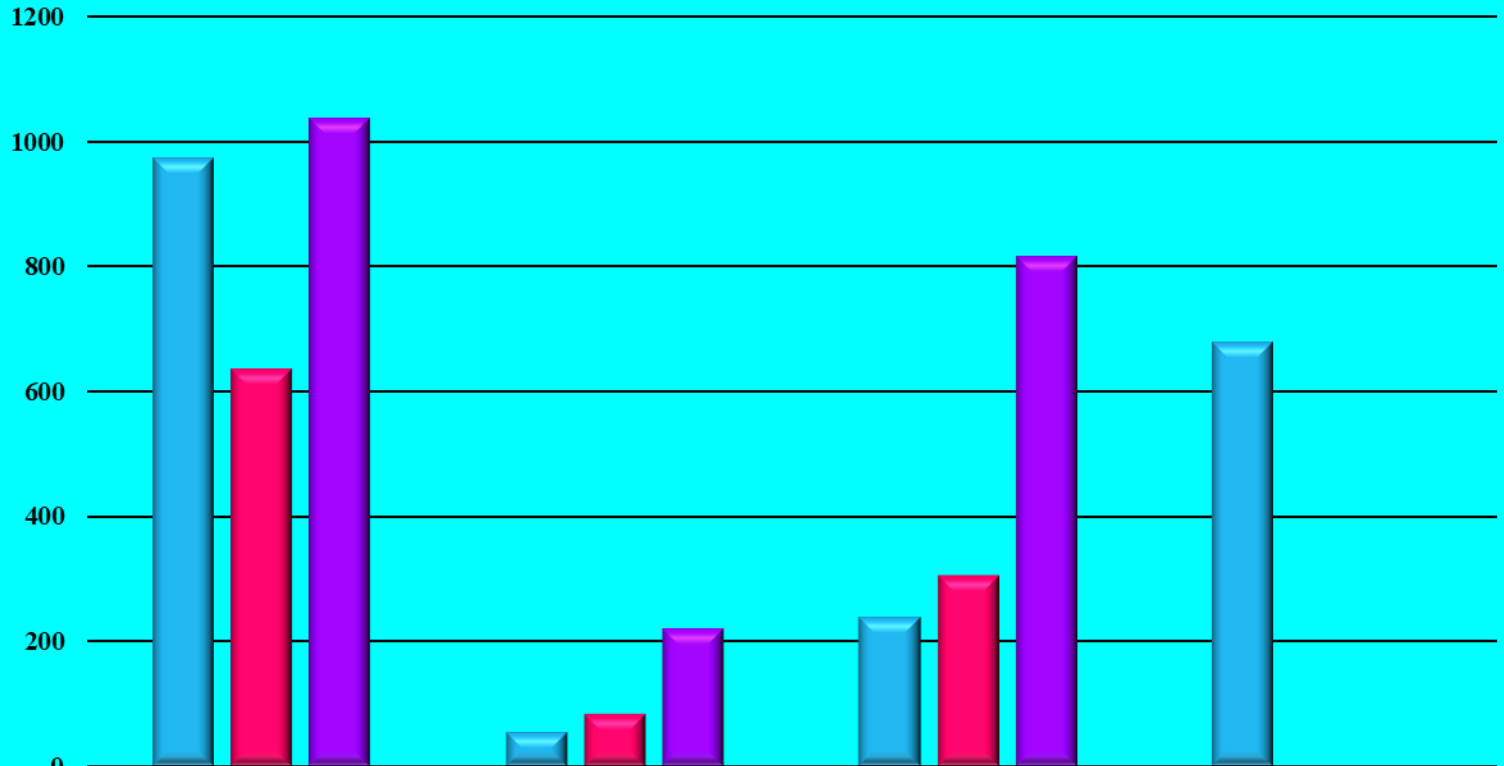

Physical Illness Requiring Emergency Room

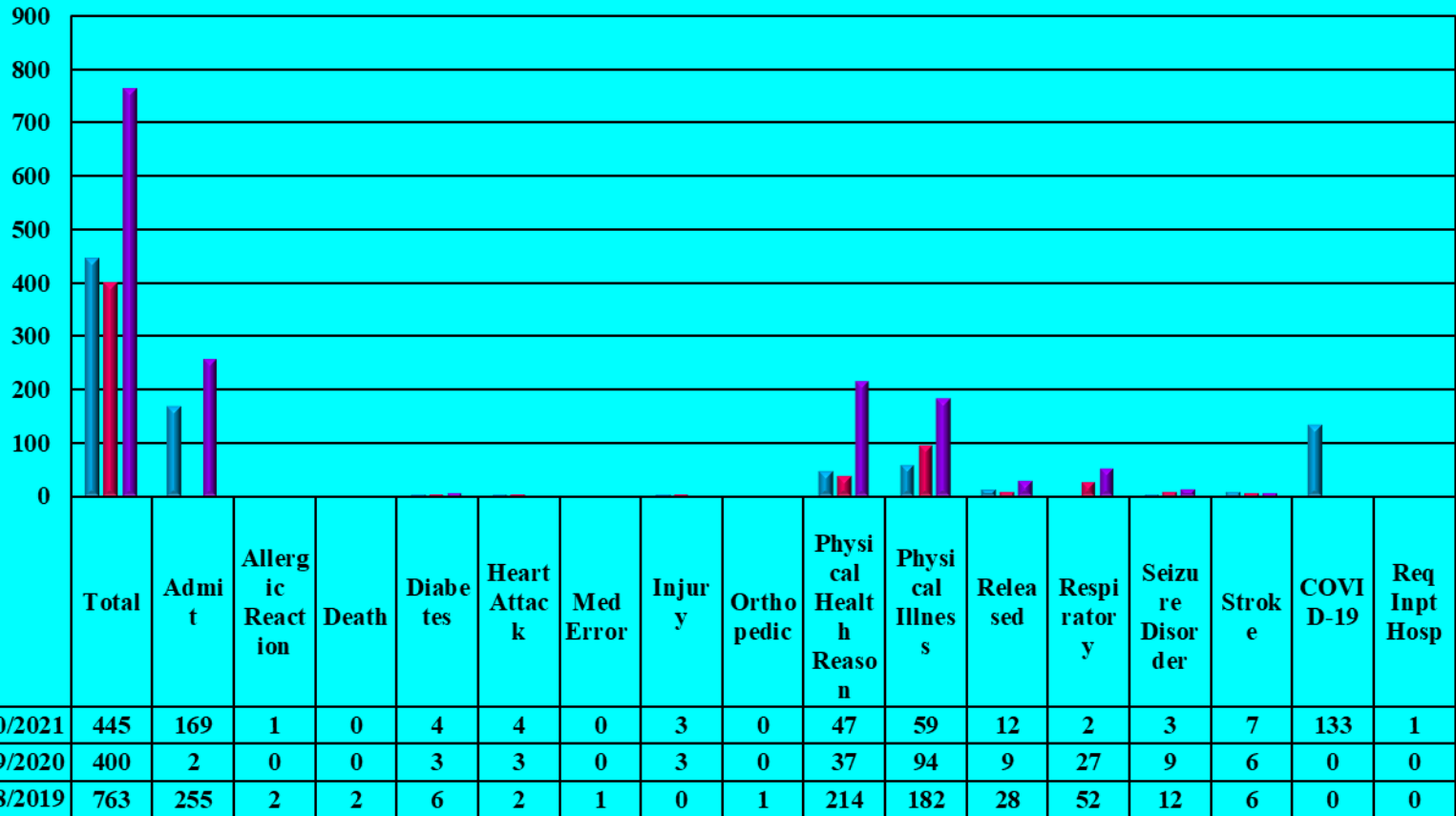

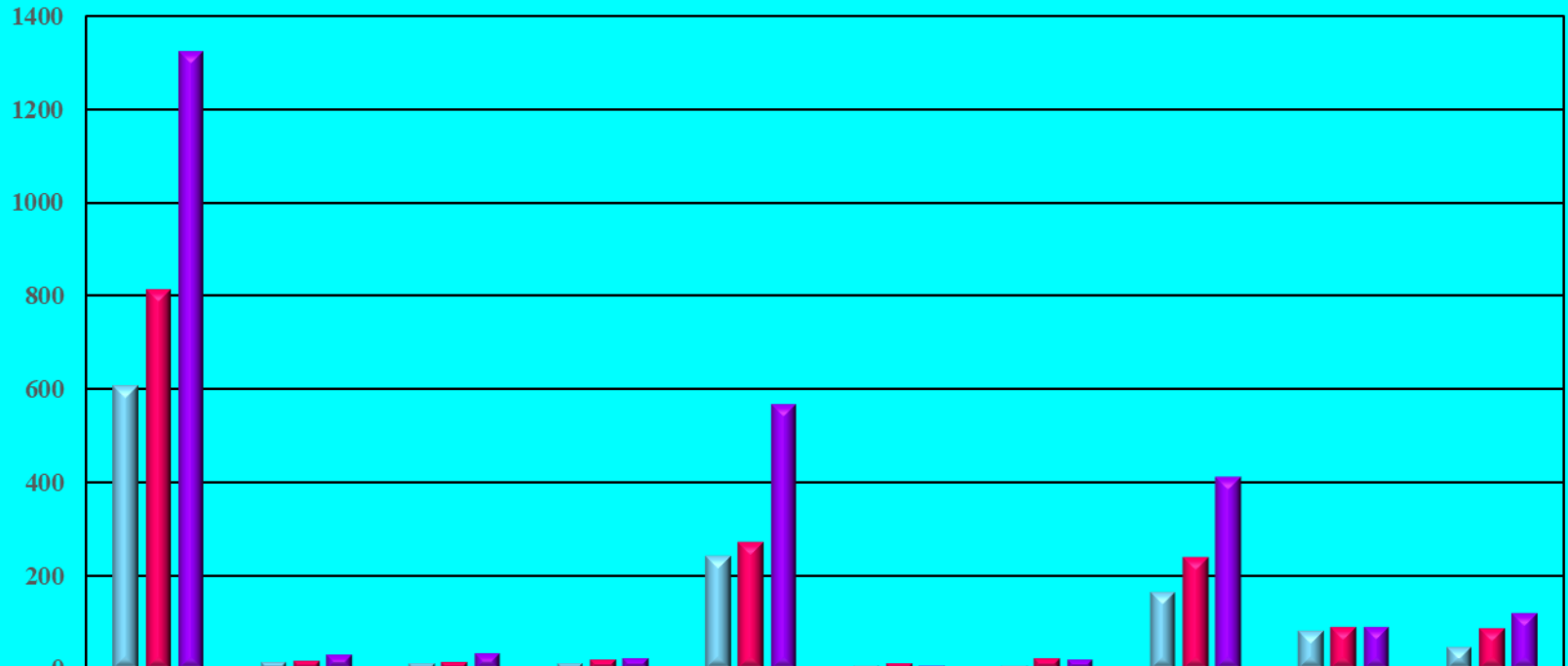
PHYSICAL ILLNESS REQUIRING HOSPITALIZATION

Serious Challenging Behavior

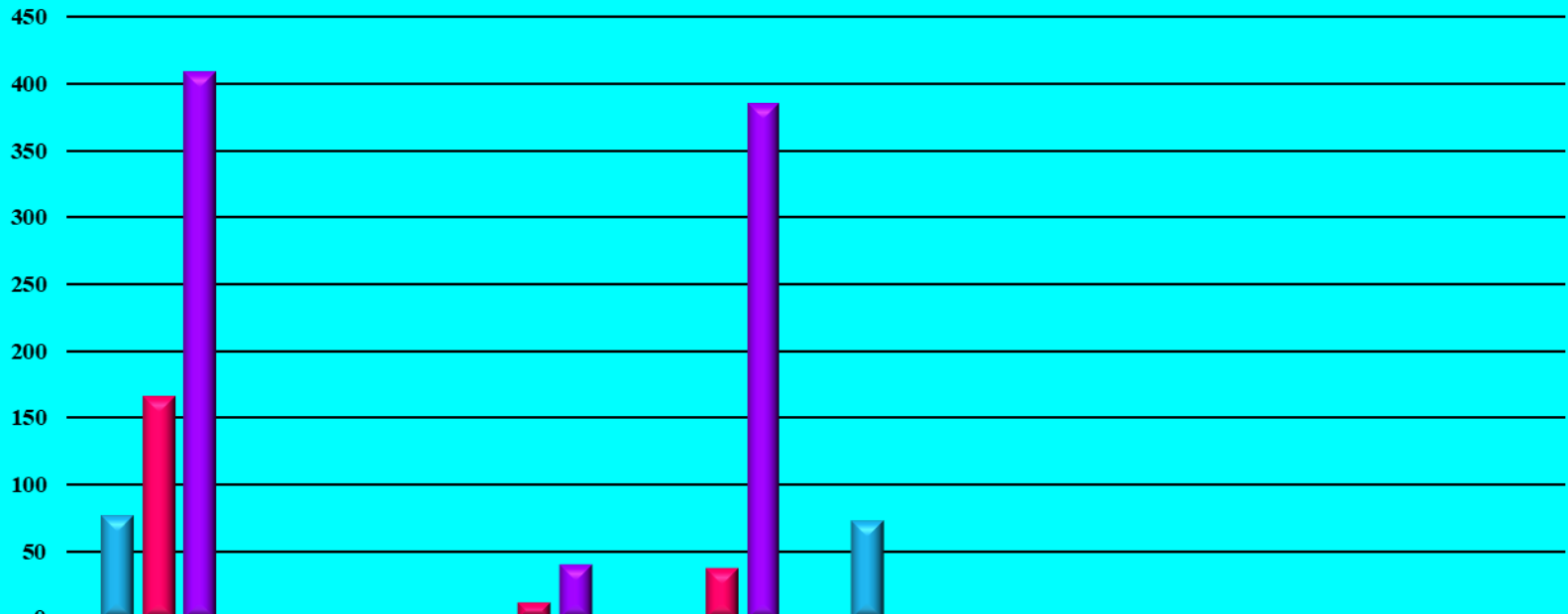
