Re: **Discontinue** submission of separate claims for Follow – Up Services for New Members

Effective immediately, please <u>discontinue</u> billing and submitting separate claims for initial assessments (H0031-BI) for new members receiving services. This communication is applicable to <u>all</u> outpatient service providers that are clinically responsible for providing and billing claims for follow-up services i.e. H0032, 90832 etc. This communication replaces the previous information provided on <u>October 9, 2019</u>. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has confirmed that services on the same claim as the assessment are allowable.
