



Clinical Markers Observable From Graph

Change in # of **severe impairments:** $\underline{2}$ at initial and $\underline{0}$ at Most Recent. Youth does not have any severe impairments, which reflects an IMPROVEMENT!!!

Change in **pervasive behavioral impairment:**<u>Present</u> at initial and <u>Present</u> at Most Recent. Pervasive behavioral impairment was present at most recent assessment, indicating continued impairment at school, in home, and in behavior towards others in general.
